Client goals

- To create a working and leisure environment in Hertfordshire where any member of the public may go about their business safely.
- To take a proactive approach to Town Centre management in close co-operation with the Police, with safety as a high priority.

Key notes

Quadrant has been working with The Hertfordshire Partnership since 1998 to develop the technology supporting the teams monitoring city centre activities and forming close relationships with Hertfordshire Police.

A migration from analogue to digital storage technology has seen an increase in operator performance and improved quality of stored images, providing all parties with powerful information that can be used to achieve their goals.

Control room upgrades to take advantage of the latest ergonomics and integrated systems have resulted in an improved operator working environment and released additional space as well as reducing paperwork. Additional space has created the opportunity to integrate radio and PA systems for operator use.

Automatic Number Plate Recognition has been introduced to the system with links to the Police. This has allowed operators and Police to focus their activities on specific areas of activity.

The deployment of wireless technology has allowed for quick deployment at reduced cost and the provision of surveillance with a shorter lead time.
